DECISION

No 1287-L of 30 September 2019

ON APPROVING THE 2020 ACTION PLAN ON COMBATING NARCOTIC DRUG ADDICTION AND TRAFFICKING IN NARCOTIC DRUGS IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE SCHEDULE THEREOF

Pursuant to Article 52 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On narcotic drugs and psychotropic (psychoactive) substances", the Government of the Republic of Armenia hereby decides:

1. To approve:
 - (1) the 2020 Action Plan on Combating Narcotic Drug Addiction and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia (hereinafter referred to as "Plan"), pursuant to Annex No 1;
 - (2) the 2020 Action Schedule for Combating Narcotic Drug Addiction and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia, pursuant to Annex No 2.
2. The Plan shall be submitted, in the manner prescribed, to the National Assembly of the Republic of Armenia as part of the draft State Budget of the Republic of Armenia.

2020 ACTION PLAN

ON COMBATING NARCOTIC DRUG ADDICTION AND TRAFFICKING IN NARCOTIC DRUGS IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Combat against distribution of narcotic drugs has a history of already more than a century, and specialists consider it to be one of the global issues of the 21st century as the abuse of narcotic drugs poses a serious threat not only to the individual but the whole society and state as well. Furthermore, trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors threatens the security and stability of the state and causes disastrous damages to the economy of the state and nation's gene pool.
2. According to the National Security Strategy of the Republic of Armenia, the distribution and transit of narcotic drugs pose an immediate threat to the national security of the country, and the participation of the Republic of Armenia in the international fight against transnational crimes, including distribution of narcotic drugs, is an action aimed at ensuring the national security in the sector of security of the state and the people.
3. For the purpose of enhancing the security and sustainable development of the Republic of Armenia, capacity development of competent state bodies in combating trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances

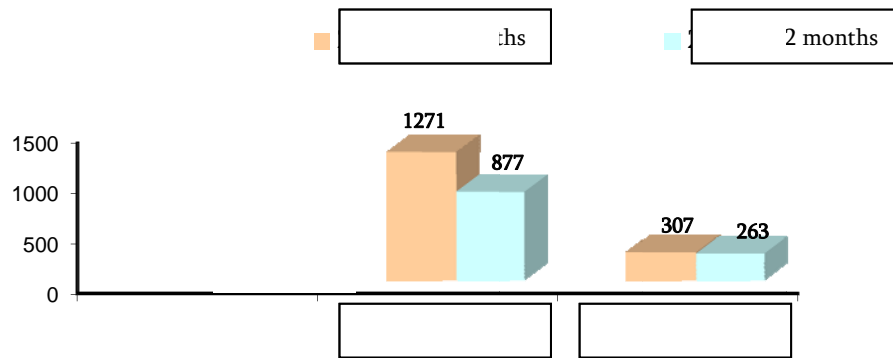
and their precursors, and raising the efficiency of their activity, as well as domestic and international co-operation in combating narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, the National Strategy for Combating Narcotic Drug Addiction and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia has been approved by Executive Order of the President of the Republic of Armenia NK-226-N of 30 December 2014, with said National Strategy identifying the strategic areas of focus for combating against the abuse of narcotic drugs and trafficking. Pursuant to point 2 of Executive Order of the President of the Republic of Armenia NK-226-N of 30 December 2014, the Government of the Republic of Armenia has been assigned to include the actions aimed at the implementation of the provisions of the Strategy in the annual plans on combating narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, for the proper implementation whereof the Police of the Republic of Armenia co-operates with almost all agencies.

4. For the purpose of promoting the international co-operation in the mentioned sector, it is necessary to develop an annual action plan which shall be aimed at preventing and revealing crimes related to narcotic drug addiction, trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors.
5. In various countries, international terrorism, extremism, trafficking, as well as other types of organised crime, the main source of funding whereof is incomes generated from the sale of narcotic drugs in the black markets, still remain as the main security threat. Moreover, despite the limited cross-border communication with the neighbouring countries, conditioned by the blockade of the Republic of Armenia imposed by Azerbaijan and Turkey, the geographical position of Armenia may, however, be attractive for transnational organised crime groups in terms of both illegal import of narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors into the Republic and their transit through its territory.

6. Trafficking in narcotic drugs is a serious threat to the security of the international community, the combat against which requires vast human and financial resources and joint efforts of states, and due to the active political, economic and cultural integration of different countries, it is impossible for one state and, moreover, one service to solve the issue of counteracting the trafficking in narcotic drugs. It is necessary to develop and implement joint prevention projects aimed at reducing the demand for narcotic drugs, which will result in the decrease of supply thereof.
7. Trafficking in narcotic drugs and drug addiction, as phenomena of spatial and extremely anti-social nature, are in the centre of attention of the global community. To the extent that, in their volumes and scales, they have encompassed all the continents, people, irrespective of their ethnic origin, gender, religion and social background.
8. For the purpose of promoting the combat against trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors in the Republic of Armenia, properly organising the process of counteraction, the interested agencies of the Republic of Armenia have implemented a number of actions of operative, preventive and organisational nature in 2019, which have been aimed at preventing and revealing such phenomena.

II. STATUS OF DRUG ADDICTION AND TRAFFICKING IN (INCLUDING THE LATENCY OF) NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC (PSYCHOACTIVE) SUBSTANCES IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA, AS WELL AS QUANTITATIVE AND QUALITATIVE CHARACTERISTICS OF SPREAD OF DRUG ADDICTION AMONG THE POPULATION, ANALYSIS OF THE STRUCTURE AND DYNAMICS OF CRIME RELATED TO TRAFFICKING IN NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC (PSYCHOACTIVE) SUBSTANCES

9. For the purpose of making the combat against trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors more active in the Republic of Armenia, as well as properly organising the process of counteracting thereto, during 2018, the Police of the Republic of Armenia has implemented a number of measures that were aimed at the prevention and detection of such phenomena.
10. During 2018, 877 cases of crime related to trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors were detected by the law enforcement bodies of the Republic, compared to 1271 recorded cases of the previous year. A decrease of 384 cases or 30.21% was recorded. The detection rate was 58% (in 2017 — 61%).
11. Out of 877 cases detected, 427 related to the illegal sale of narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors, thus, compared to 2017, a decrease of 185 cases or 30.2% was observed.
12. During the same period, 263 cases of administrative violations were recorded (307 during last year). The decrease was 44 cases or 14.3%.



13. Decrease in indicators of the combat against crimes related to narcotic drugs during the reporting period is conditioned by a number of circumstances.
14. First of all, the political developments in the country during the current year, as well as the involvement of the Police forces in the most important events of public importance (elections of local self-government bodies, Council of the city of Yerevan, National Assembly, Francophonie Summit), and then, the analysis of the crimes related to narcotic drugs detected during 2017-2018 shows that the latency of this offence remains high, besides, the complete picture of crime is not reflected in the quantitative indicators of the recorded crimes.
15. The schematic diagram of crimes related to trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors for 2017-2018 is the following:

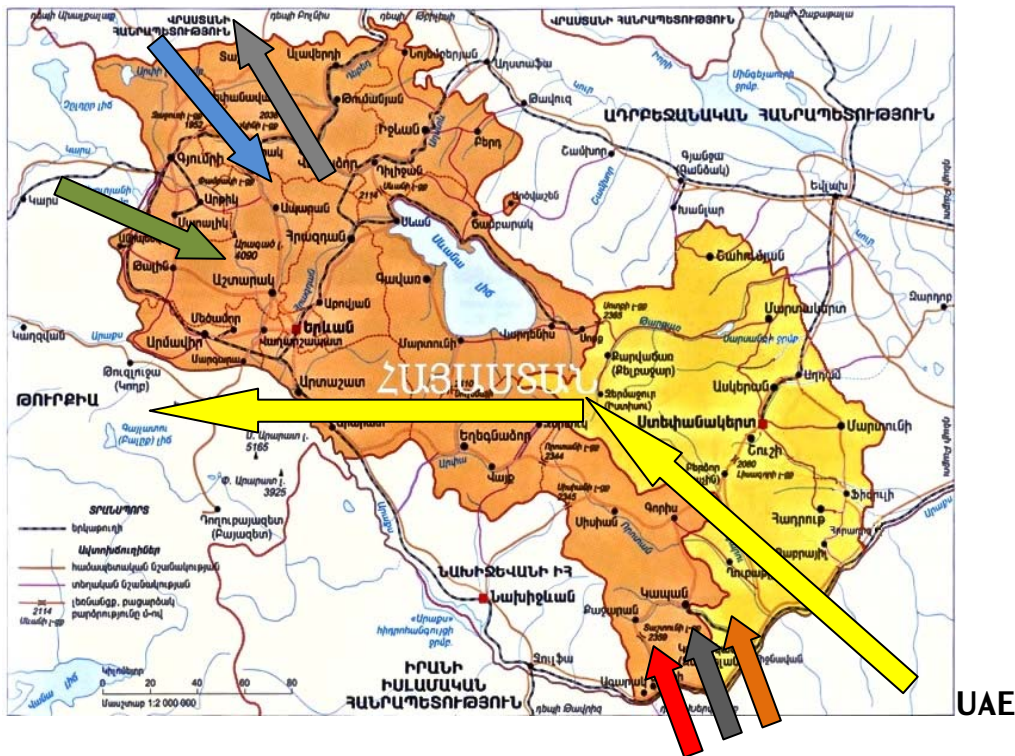
16. 211 of the mentioned cases remained undisclosed (192 — in 2017), of which 173 — with the elements of Article 266, 12 — of Article 268, and the rest — of other Articles of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Armenia.

17. The schematic diagram of persons brought to liability for crimes related to trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors for 2017-2018 is the following:

18. According to the information received from the Criminal Forensics Department of the Police of the Republic of Armenia, "National Bureau of Expertises" SNCO of the National Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Armenia and "Expertise Centre of the Republic of Armenia" SNCO, 135 kg 383 g of different types of narcotic drugs were confiscated from trafficking and presented for expertise as a result of the measures taken by the law enforcement bodies of the Republic of Armenia during 2018 (151 kg 506 g — during 2017).
19. "Opium" (**red arrow**) and "methamphetamine" (**black arrow**) included in the group of so-called "heavy" narcotic drugs are mainly illegally imported from the Islamic Republic of Iran. The essential part of "Hashish" type of narcotic drug (**orange arrow**) being consumed in the Republic of Armenia is also imported from Iran.
20. In 2018, cases of import of "Methamphetamine" type of narcotic drug (**green arrow**) from European countries to the Republic of Armenia were recorded.
21. In recent years, due to the measures jointly implemented by the Police of the Republic of Armenia, the National Security Service of the Republic of Armenia, officers of the Border Guard Troops of the National Security Service of the Republic of Armenia, employees of Department for the Fight against Smuggling of the State Revenue Committee of the Republic of Armenia, several criminal groups engaged in illegal transportation of the mentioned narcotic drugs from the Islamic Republic of Iran, European countries and the USA were detected, which attempted to use the territory of the Republic of Armenia as a transit route (Iran-Armenia-Far East countries) for the transportation of narcotic drugs of "Opium" type (**black arrow**).
22. The narcotic pill "Subutex" the confiscation of which has increased in recent years both by air and by international mail, is imported from Europe, in particular from France (**blue arrow**).

23. The narcotic drug "Cocaine" is imported to the Republic of Armenia mainly from Islamic Republic of Iran and European countries (Poland, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, etc.). It is also noteworthy the case of using the territory of the Republic of Armenia as a transit route and smuggling of particularly large amount of narcotic drug of "Cocaine" type during the reporting period (flight: Brazil-UAE-Armenia-Turkey). **(yellow arrow)**



24. The narcotic drugs found in the body systems of the persons presented for expertise by law enforcement bodies of the Republic of Armenia to the "Republican Narcology Centre" CJSC of the Ministry of Healthcare of the Republic of Armenia and the "National Bureau of Expertises" SNCO of the National Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Armenia during the reporting period, by groups.

25. According to the data submitted by the "Republican Narcology Centre" CJSC of the Ministry of Healthcare of the Republic of Armenia on 1 January 2018, 6544 narcotic drug addicts are record-registered with the diagnosis of "narcotic drug addict", of which 4065 are cannabinoid addicts, 2476 — opioid addicts, 3 — cocaine addicts.
26. In the Republic of Armenia, 298 beneficiaries are currently record-registered in Yerevan, 16 — in Vanadzor, 9 — in Gyumri, 16 — in Kapan, and 156 — in penitentiary institutions of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Armenia within the framework of the "Provision of Methadone Substitution Treatment from Opioid Substances" programme.

III. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE PLAN

27. This Plan identifies multiple goals which address all the fields of the combat against narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs and includes the focus areas defined by the previous annual plans.
28. Actions presented in this Plan are aimed at efficiently organising the combat against narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs in the Republic of Armenia and shall be implemented in compliance with the principles prescribed by Article 6 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On narcotic drugs and psychotropic (psychoactive) substances".
29. Based on the provisions of the National Strategy for Combating Drug Addiction and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia, the main goals of the 2020 Plan on Combating Narcotic Drug Addiction and Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia is be the following:
 - (1) creation of necessary conditions for decreasing the rate of crimes related to trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors;
 - (2) elimination of conditions contributing to and root causes of narcotic drug addiction, trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors;
 - (3) primary prevention of and revealing narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, ensuring the coordinated activity of law enforcement bodies and other organisations for this purpose.
30. The main objectives of the Plan are:
 - (1) raising the effectiveness of the co-operation of state bodies, aimed at the primary prevention of and at revealing trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors, and crimes related thereto;

- (2) improvement of the legislative framework and ensuring its applicability, in particular, comprehensive analysis of the laws and other legal acts of the Republic of Armenia regulating the combat against drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, improvement thereof and bringing them in line with the requirements of the international agreements of the Republic of Armenia;
- (3) primary prevention of narcotic drug addiction, decrease of narcotic drug addiction through prevention and efficient medical treatment;
- (4) reduction of the volume of trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors;
- (5) efficient organisation of the medical treatment of persons addicted to narcotic drugs, modernisation of narcological services and introduction of a social rehabilitation system;
- (6) development and enhancement of international as well as inter-agency co-operation in the field combat against narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs;
- (7) raising awareness of the population of the dangers of illicit use of narcotic drugs and psychotropic (psychoactive) substances;
- (8) ensuring supervision over the wholesale trade of precursors and steps aimed at detection of illegal trade or underground laboratories;
- (9) raising awareness of minors of narcotic drug addiction and the harm caused thereby, as in many countries of the world children are used as consumers of illicit narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, which represents a terrible danger.

31. Based on the goals and objectives defined by this Plan, the law enforcement bodies of the Republic of Armenia actively participate in and implement various actions. In particular:

- (1) for the purpose of preventing and revealing smuggling of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors into the territory of the Republic of Armenia, the law enforcement bodies of the Republic of Armenia actively participate in "Kanal" ("Channel") anti-drug operation permanently conducted among the Member States of the Collective Security Treaty Organisation;
- (2) "Kanep-Kakach" ("Cannabis-Poppy") complex operative and preventive measure is also conducted within the whole territory of the Republic of Armenia each year, wherein officers of the Police of the Republic of Armenia, subdivisions of the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Armenia, representatives of local self-government bodies and the mass media are involved.

IV. MAIN FOCUS AREAS OF THE PLAN

32. For the purpose of organising the combat against narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors more efficiently, in 2020 it is appropriate to implement a number of actions in the following areas of focus:
 - (1) improve the legal acts of the Republic of Armenia and bring them in line with the international agreements, at the same time ensuring their applicability. For this purpose, it is necessary to conduct an ongoing systemic analysis of the domestic legal acts of the Republic of Armenia and, where appropriate, submit recommendations on making amendments and supplements thereto in compliance with the provisions of the UN 1961, 1971 and 1988 Conventions and international instruments;
 - (2) conduct operative and preventive and special measures in the combat against narcotic drug addiction, narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances

and their precursors. In this area of focus, it is necessary to strengthen the control in border crossing points and customs control zones of the Republic of Armenia over smuggling of narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors, ensure efficient border monitoring;

- (3) improve the efficiency of the combat against narcotic drug addiction among military, co-operate in the works aimed at comprehensively and fully revealing each case of narcotic drugs found among military;
- (4) intensify the programmes on the media on the damages caused by and consequences of narcotic drug addiction, invite relevant specialist doctors, psychologists and pedagogues to participate in these programmes;
- (5) raise the awareness of the population of the damage caused due to narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs. In this area of focus, it is necessary to continue the activities for raising the awareness of the population of narcotic drug addiction and the combat against trafficking in narcotic drugs, especially among risk groups;
- (6) study the best international practices in combating distribution of narcotic drugs, including organise professional trainings for officers involved in this field at educational institutions of the states of the Commonwealth of Independent States, the Collective Security Treaty Organisation and other European states, conduct seminars and consultations with a view to introducing the international practices in the Republic of Armenia;
- (7) implement actions for the medical treatment and rehabilitation of persons using narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances; in this area of focus, it will prove useful to modernise the narcological services, ensure close co-operation between non-governmental organisations implementing prevention projects among the population and persons using narcotic drugs and medical institutions providing narcological medical aid and services,

ensure activities for persons record-registered with the narcological service;

- (8) implement events dedicated to the healthy lifestyle among minors and the youth; for that purpose, it will be necessary to organise and hold events including sport and curative activities, as well as mass sports events, conduct seminars on combating narcotic drug addiction, campaign through electronic media and mass media with a view to ensuring activities for minors and preventing the use of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances by them.

V. FUNDING OF THE PLAN

33. It is planned to cover the financial expenses required for the implementation of the actions provided for by the Plan from the following sources:
 - (1) amounts allocated from the State Budget of the Republic of Armenia to the relevant state body for the current year;
 - (2) funds from international organisations, as well as donor states with respect to technical and advisory support;
 - (3) other sources.

VI. OUTCOMES EXPECTED FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAN

34. The actions to be implemented within the scope of the Plan will have their positive impact on the prevention of narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs. In particular, the outcomes expected from the implementation of the Plan are:

- (1) improvement of the legislative framework necessary for combating narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, bringing it in line with the international commitments of the Republic of Armenia;
- (2) raising the level of awareness among the population of the damage caused due to narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs and awareness of the possibilities to combat it;
- (3) strengthening the control over narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs, including smuggling of narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors through border customs points;
- (4) reduction of the supply of and demand for narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and their precursors;
- (5) increase of the quality and efficiency of treatment of narcological patients;
- (6) raising and enhancing the efficiency of the work and co-operation of law enforcement bodies in the field of combating narcotic drug addiction and trafficking in narcotic drugs.
- (7) upgrading the logistics base will contribute to the effectiveness of research and identification of new narcotic drugs, psychotropic (psychoactive) substances and their precursors, in particular, the detection of synthetic cannabinoids in tobacco mixes, as the equipment being used is very obsolete and almost useless for further use.
